- Report on regulatory development and Compliance risk exposure to the iptiQ board of directors and relevant committees and input to Swiss Re Compliance reports
- Provide relevant reporting to regulatory/competent authorities as appropriate

- Providing compliance advice on oversight of distributors and outsourced service providers as part of the oversight framework and conducting specific compliance oversight as required
- Develop tailored trainings, communications and targeted local policy and framework documents where needed; and support the implementation of new global standards
- Support the Assurance teams working in close collaboration with Group Internal Audit and Risk Management
- Monitor regulatory developments at national and EU level and assessment of published regulatory changes.
